Mary Francis married Eli Haskins; had one daughter Rachel... whom did she marry, and how can we get information to date?

Your letter mentions "Christena" Francis who married Joseph Hanna. Is this a nickname for Christiana Francis? In the old, old list of the children of James and Rachel Francis, evidently copied by some scrivener from early family records, the name is given as Christiana- born in 1826, died 1884. Is this not the same person, and shouldn't the name be Christiana?

I wrote Fred Hanna, Port Carlin, Ont., for information in November 1935, but had no reply. Will try again, unless you can suggest some other way to learn about the Hanna branch of the family.

Wish you tell me the history about Rachel Hanna, of whom I know so little.

Since I wrote you first about this matter you may have thought more about it, and will have some other information to give me. If some of the early letters could only be found, much help could be gotten but wherever I've asked I've learned about bonfires.
