Dear Edgar:

Glad to receive your letter of the 3rd. Re our family.

In 1938 I sent you an old letter I had, of which you made a copy. It was from Pawtucket R.I.

Joseph Anderson of Toronto married Margaret Francis, my father's sister. ----[some name] - father was Jonathan Francis not of Toronto, but Pakenham, Ont.

I have no other information I am sorry. Although I did hear that they came to Canada on the same ship landing in early spring in 1821 at Perth Ontario or Brockville or Prescott. I have heard Perth, as the Bryson's which were my mothers people. The Brysons came from Paisley Scotland.

I certainly am anxious to trace the family. When in Scotland last year I got word (wind) of a Scots Ancester Research Society, but have heard nothing since.

I cannot find Lissacurran, on my map of Ireland. But I have heard Dad mention the Irancis came from County Antrim. Did you not say they were in the lumber business?

I will give you all the help I can.

Our crop was a complete "frost" we got badly frozen in August.... Have ... all ... and,, this had is all feed. Awful stuff. (This paragraph is very difficult to read, maybe at another time the original of this letter can be compared to Jonathan's handwritting elsewhere.)

Kindest regards to Mrs. Francis Jean and family, and yourself.
