

Former Cobden Magistrate, J. Warren Dies in Ottawa

Joseph R. Warren, former magistrate of Cobden, Ont., died at a local hospital yesterday following a short illness. He was in his 83rd year.

Born at Eganville, a son of the late William Warren and his wife, the late Jane Leach, he received his education there and at Pembroke. Mr. Warren moved to Cobden as a young man and for many years was the town magistrate. He retired about 20 years ago. For the past year he had been residing with his daughter, Mrs. H. W. Stephens, 106 Strathcona avenue. Mr. Warren was an adherent of the Church of England. He married Mary Elizabeth Sykes in 1883. She predeceased him about five years ago.

Surviving are one son, W. C. Warren of Vancouver, B.C., and a daughter, Mrs. H. W. Stephens.

The funeral service will be conducted at the residence of his daughter, 106 Strathcona avenue, on Saturday afternoon at 1 o'clock. Burial will be at Boyd cemetery.
