Central School from Grade 3 to Grade 8. In 1946 She began Carleton Place High School from which she graduated in June 1951. She began training for Nursing at the Kingston General Hospital in September 1951. She left in December 1951. 1952 - 53 Helen attended Carleton College, 1953 - 54 Helen attended Ottawa Teacher's College from which she graduated in 1954. September 1954 Helen began teaching for the City of Ottawa Public School board. She began her career teaching Grades 3 - 4 at Osgoode Street School. She also taught at Bel - Air Grades 5, Remedial English to French Immersion, Library and Special Education. D. Roy Kennedy Grades 5 Agincourt Library and Cambridge Street Special Education. While growing up Helen attended Mission Band, Brownies, C.G.I.T. and Young Peoples. She was a member of the High School Glee Club and St. Andrew's Church Choir.
